8. Once your password is save, you will be directed to the first page you accessed:



This time, enter your User Name and Password to sign in. Note that you can log in at any time with these same credentials to take additional training.

9. Once logged in, you will see the main MyScouting site. Click on E-Learning is the left sided menu:



- Click on the 'Cub Scout' tab, and click on 'Take Course' next to Youth Protection Training (or which ever other training course you wish to take).
