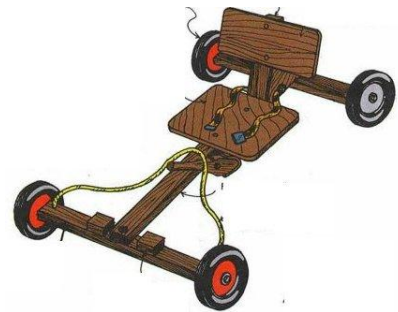


RULES AND SAFETY INFORMATION

While we look forward to a fun day of racing, safety for our Scouts is our first priority. All carts will be inspected prior to the race to insure they adhere to the rules. Any non-conforming car must be made to conform before it will be allowed to compete.

GO-CART CONSTRUCTION RULES

- Go-Carts are to be constructed **exclusively** from the set of parts provided in the official Pack 811 Go-Cart Kit of materials which you receive from Mike Rivera.
- **No additional or replacement materials may be used** for the construction of the go-cart. (For example, you may **not** use nails in place of screws; you may **not** utilize a 4x4 wooden post in place of the 2x4 post that has been provided, etc)
- Materials may **not** be modified in any way (i.e., lumber may **not** be cut shorter)
- **No additional weight** is to be added to the go-cart.
- Every go-cart seat must be appropriately placed to comfortably and safely fit the designated riders on the team.
- All go-carts must include the safety belt that has been provided.
- Go-carts may be decorated with paint, decals, glitter, paper, pictures, etc. Scouts should get as creative as possible!
- Parents are encouraged to guide and supervise the construction and decoration of the cart, but the kit is designed to be able to be put together by Scouts.



GO-CART SAFETY RULES

- All riders must use the seatbelt.
- All go-cart riders must wear Class B uniform and closed-toed shoes. Absolutely no sandals or flip-flops. Long pants (jeans) are suggested.
- All riders must wear a well-fitted bicycle or scooter helmet.
